We want to share a special child with you and show you how you're making a difference! This is Miracle Misuli. She is five years old. She has been one of our students for the past two years. She is very well behaved and very intelligent. She's one of the brightest students on our campus. Her favorite hobby is singing. During recess, you can oftentimes hear her singing softly with such a beautiful voice. Sometimes she can even draw a crowd with her singing. She enjoys playing with other children and loves to have fun! She's very attentive in class and demonstrates great leadership on a weekly basis by setting a good behavioral example for the other students to follow. We wanted to share this child with you because you are currently making a positive impact on her life. You help provide the basic necessities that she needs on a daily basis. Necessities that she otherwise wouldn't have access to; clean water, two warm meals, food snack, education, and playtime with her peers. These resources help her to grow and develop and most importantly instill hope that there is no limit to her dreams!

BCV FARMING! Sustainability

We are fortunate to have successfully broaden our income platform through the last several years. It has been our goal from our inception to reliably address the needs of the children we serve through providing food, shelter, education, clothing, medical care, etc. To do this, we believe that we have to evolve from being solely reliant on donations. Thankfully, through your efforts we have done this.

Farming is one way that we improve our economic and financial sustainability. A few years ago we acquired neighboring property that borders one of the rivers stemming from Mt. Mulanje (Africa's



third tallest mountain). Through that acquisition we have developed, irrigated and cultivated part of that property to maintain a mineral rich rice field, or paddy field. A rice field is a flooded field of arable land used for growing semiaquatic crops, most notably rice and taro. Our fields are used solely for rice. We are then able to cook this rice and directly feed our children! Through this rice field we have been able to reduce our spending and net an annual savings of over \$3,750 USD.
