on the included chart, about 85% of all the deaths that resulted from this cyclone came from Malawi. Also, 86% of all the injuries came from Malawi. What we want you to know is that God protects his children. God protected us. God protected BCV. We did not have any loss of life or injuries to any of our children or staff at our campus!

However, the impact of this storm was greatest on our livestock. We sustained some significant loss to

our livestock due to the drop in temperatures, wind chill and flooding. We lost nearly half of our cattle livestock as our herd was reduced from 31 to 17. Also, our goats were reduced from 60 down to 10. The great news is we have two new goat births and we are up to 12 goats! We've also had four new cow births and we're at 21 cows now! Thank you for your continued prayers and support!
